

Vector Conversion			
How?	Raster to vector conversion (Vectorization) of Crests/Logos/Paintings. This vectorization service is offered to deliver output of the highest quality. To vectorize the image we use CorelDraw although the output can be of any vector format. There are many raster to vector converting programs, our artists have mastered the art to convert vector files manually by drawing (using CorelDraw) every line in order to restrain file size and quality.		
What?	More often than not, a piece of letterhead or a business card is offered as "art" for a logo. Rarely is it a digital file. If it is a digital file, it is usually a raster image (.tiff, .jpeg, .bmp, etc . . .) The best choice for logos and other line art is an EPS file (Encapsulated Post Script). EPS files are typically generated from vector based programs such as Adobe Illustrator, Macromedia Freehand, or CorelDraw. EPS files are fully scaleable and are not susceptible to distortion. Also, spot colors are easily specified in vector programs, which comes in handy if your project is not going to be produced in 4-color process.		
Advantages of Vector Art	<p>Resolution Independent: A vector converted image has no jaggedness, no loss in detail and can be printed at any resolution.</p> <p>Size Independent: The image can be scaled up or down without any loss in quality.</p> <p>Can be Updated or Partially Changed: A library can be maintained and can be updated or partially changed.</p> <p>Can be archived and stored for later use: The archive of the artwork can be used for Literature, Manuals, Brochures, Newspapers, Service bulletins and host of areas.</p>

Professional Vector Conversion Services	Our digitizing services will allow you to convert any logo or graphic to vector format. If you have an old logo, graphic or artwork that is hand drawn or scanned, it can be digitized. All we need from you is a scan or copy of the image to be digitized, just clear enough to see details.		
What is a Bitmap?	Bitmap images are made up of pixels, and cannot be scaled up effectively. On the other hand VECTOR images are created by the numerical coordinates that are contained within the file. Vector images can be scaled up or down infinitely without the loss of resolution and are much smaller files compared to bitmap files. Vector images also allow you to change color and edit individual elements with ease.		
How Much?	The cost is based on the complexity of the artwork. Simple basic shapes require little time of the artists and are therefore the least expensive. Complexity adds to the artist's required time and will indeed vary the final price. After you upload your file we will give you a cost to convert the file to vector format and you will sign off on a work order before we commence.
